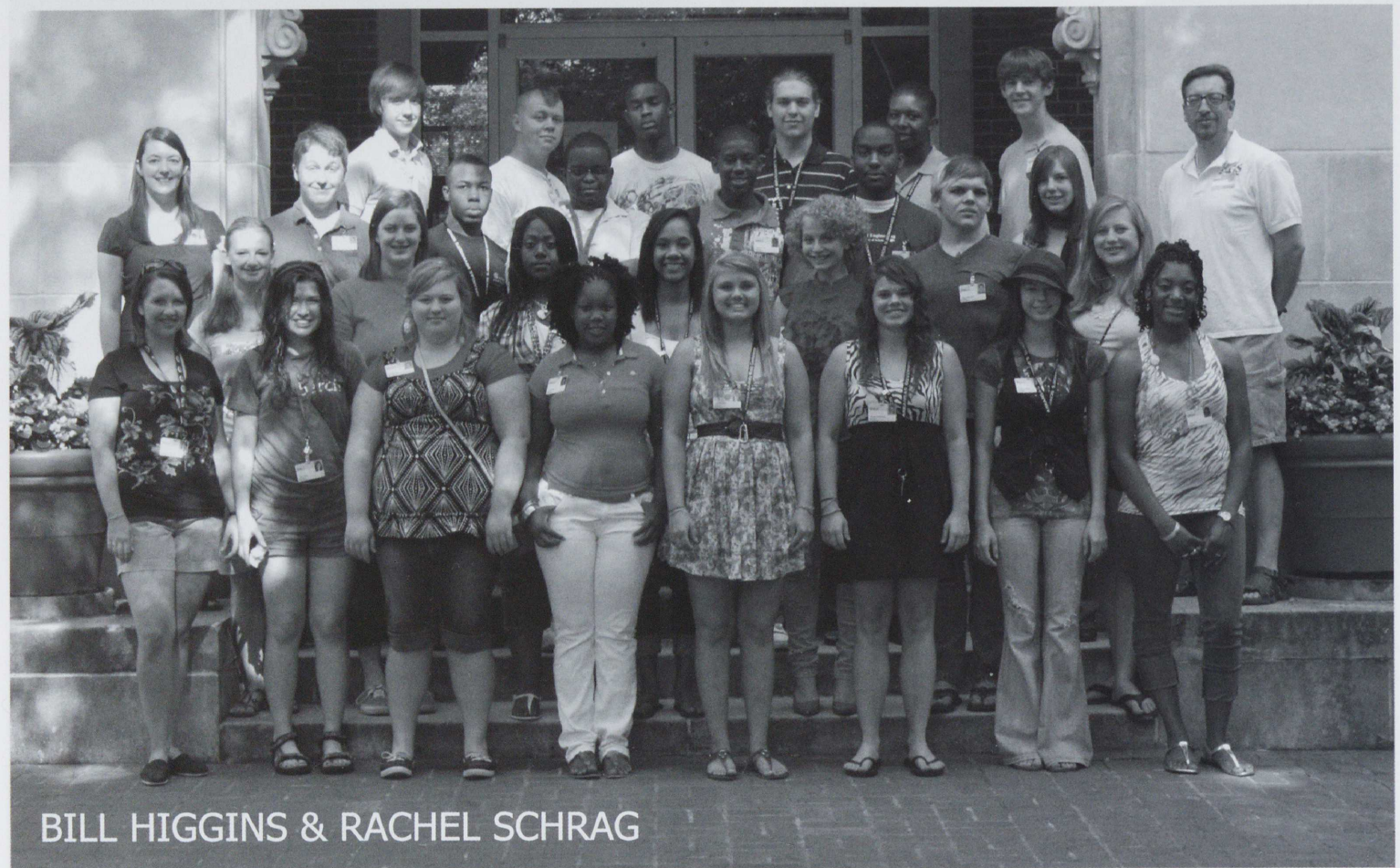
ACADEMICS & THE ARTS
